TreeGivingDay 2024

On 8 march 2024 the truck with the 4,000 Shiny Oak trees arrived at Oldonyong'iro village, to be distributed to the farmers we had invited to come. The interest was so great that we had to reduce the number of trees per farmer to provide for everyone.

270 farmers registered for 5-20 trees, so we expect that more than 300 new owners have some trees planted at their farmland to enjoy the benefits of having trees.

Leaders of the village have formed an environmental conservation committee, that will help to work closely with farmers to make sure the trees are cared well. We wanted to thank our partner and donors on Global Giving for making this day possible and maybe you can join us next year!
